

## **GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT IN YOUR REGION**

### What is the future of groundwater management?

North Fork Kings GSA is the Groundwater Sustainability Agency leading the way to better management and balance of groundwater supplies in your area. The Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) is an unfunded State law requiring groundwater subbasins be sustainable by 2040. The North Fork Kings GSA is focused on providing solutions. In the coming years, projects and management tools will be implemented to reach sustainability of our groundwater resource.

## What are current groundwater conditions?

North Fork Kings GSA technical consultants have spent the last two years gathering and analyzing data on groundwater conditions. Ultimately, the data tells us the amount of groundwater overdraft occurring that must be reduced to achieve sustainability.

## THE ROADMAP TO SUSTAINABILITY: THE GSP

#### What is a GSP?

A Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) is a roadmap for how a subbasin will avoid the negative effects of overpumping and lays out a plan to achieve a sustainable groundwater supply. North Fork Kings GSA's draft GSP is now available for 90-day public review through October 21st. You can download a copy of the draft GSP and submit comments at www.northforkkings.org/gspcomment.

## What's in the GSP?



Current and historic groundwater conditions



A path forward for groundwater sustainability, including projects and management actions

\*Projects and Management Actions listed to the right have not been decided by the Board of the North Fork Kings GSA. These are potential mitigation tools to reduce groundwater overdraft. They are included in the GSP, but may or may not be implemented in the future. The North Fork Kings GSA Board's priority is to increase water supply before reducing water demand.


