General Manager Mendes provided a report on recent matters as follows:

Rural Advisory Communities Committee

The Rural Advisory Communities Committee met on March 14, 2024. Discussion was related to well mitigation. The RACC should meet again on May 2, 2024

Policy Committee

The Policy Committee did not meet in March due to a lack of a quorum.

Finance Committee

The Finance Committee met on March 21, 2024. Discussion was to go over the Engineer's Report that will be reviewed later in the agenda.

Technical Advisory Committee

The Technical Advisory Committee did not meet in March due to a lack of a quorum. .

Grower Advisory Committee

The Grower Advisory Committee met on March 27, 2024. Discussed some annual report data and few other monitoring items. Did an update on the well registration program.

Subbasin Coordination

General Manager Mendes provided a report on Subbasin efforts. The Subbasin group met this last month. The group reviewed comments on the domestic well mitigation program. Another draft is expected in April. Other GSAs now want to discuss a Sustainable Yield allocation and other methodologies. The discussion will continue.

Consulting Engineer Johansen reported subbasin coordination will continue work on mitigation program. Efforts are also underway with the confined aquifer study through EKI. Interconnected Surface Waters is another area which is required to be addressed.
